

PRIVACY POLICY AND DECLARATION OF CONSENT TO PROCESSING PERSONAL DATA

All personal data will be processed in accordance with the applicable legislation regarding the processing of personal data, namely Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to respect to the processing of personal data and the free movement of such data and which repeals Directive 95/46 / EC (General Data Protection Regulation).

1. Responsible for the processing of personal data

2. Purpose of the processing of personal data

- a. The Provision of IT Consulting Services for Companies**
- b. Provision of Software Development**

The personal data collected will be processed for the performance of the services contracted by the data holder to Unicage, which include conducting consulting services, in person or online, lectures, workshops or webinars, as well as for the respective billing process for these services, their treatment being lawful and strictly necessary for the purpose for which it is intended, based on art. 6 (1) (b) of the GDPR.

c. Data for the purpose of disseminating and promoting services

3. Data Collection Process

4. Recipients of personal data

5. Categories of personal data processed

6. Period of retention of personal data

The personal data collected will be retained as long as the provision of Software Development and IT Consulting services for Companies and for the purpose of disseminating and promoting services remains up to 7 years after the contractual relationship ends, being destroyed after this period.

7. How do we keep your personal data safe?

Although data transmission over the internet or websites cannot guarantee complete security against intrusions, we and our service providers and business partners strive to implement and maintain physical, electronic and procedural security measures designed to protect your personal data in accordance with the applicable data protection requirements.

8. Partners or associate links

9. How can the holder of personal data exercise his rights?

The data collected for the provision of Software Development and IT Consulting services for Companies are strictly necessary for the provision of requested services.

When selecting this option, I give my free and informed consent for the use of my personal data for the purposes of disseminating and promoting Unicage services, and at any time I can withdraw my consent, without compromising the lawfulness of the treatment carried out with based on the consent previously given. After withdrawing consent, the data subject will no longer be contacted and receive communications for the purposes described in this Privacy Policy.

The holder of personal data has the right to access his data, as well as the right to rectify inaccurate or incomplete data. You also have the right to delete your personal data (with some limitations provided for in article 17, (3) of the GDPR) and the right to limit the processing of data.
